Environmental Policy

POLICY STATEMENT

1. Taysha Consulting, Ltd. (Taysha) recognises that businesses are responsible for achieving good environmental practice and operating in a sustainable manner.  - iv. Assess the environmental impact of any initiatives undertaken in the normal course of business and take steps to mitigate where feasible.
 - v. Reduce carbon footprint through environmentally aware travel practices across projects by minimising air travel, encouraging car-sharing and use of public transport.
